

  Corridors to FRA
- November 2023
  FRA has yet to announce

# What Funding Sources are Available?

Florida Rail Enterprise - \$60 million in annual state funds to support operations, maintenance, and rail systems planning.

Federal Railroad Administration – oversees federal discretionary grant programs to fund corridor development, service plans, and capital projects.

Amtrak – receives federally appropriated funds administered annually by FRA to support capital projects, maintenance activities, debt service payments, and operating expenses on the national network.




